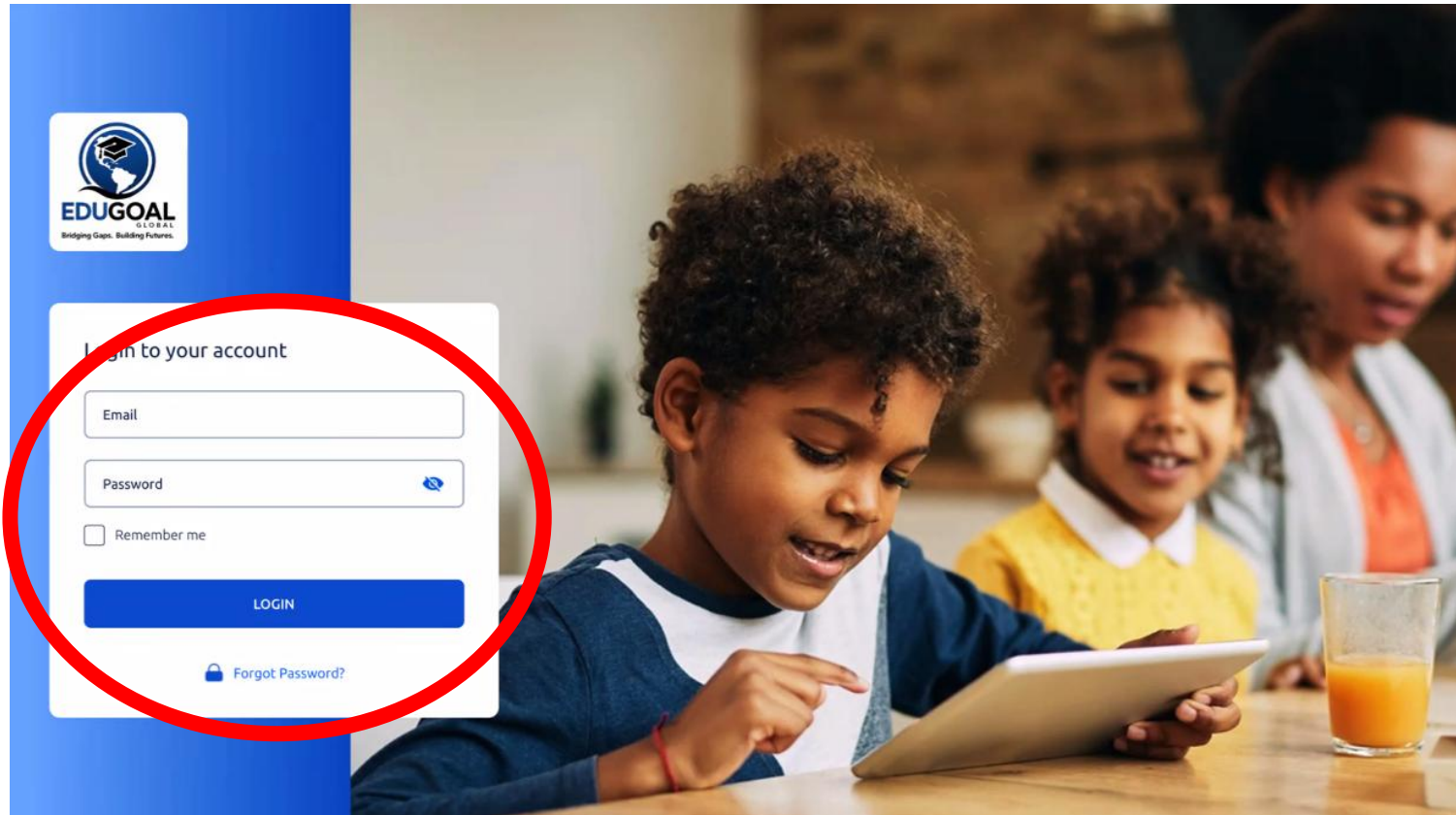

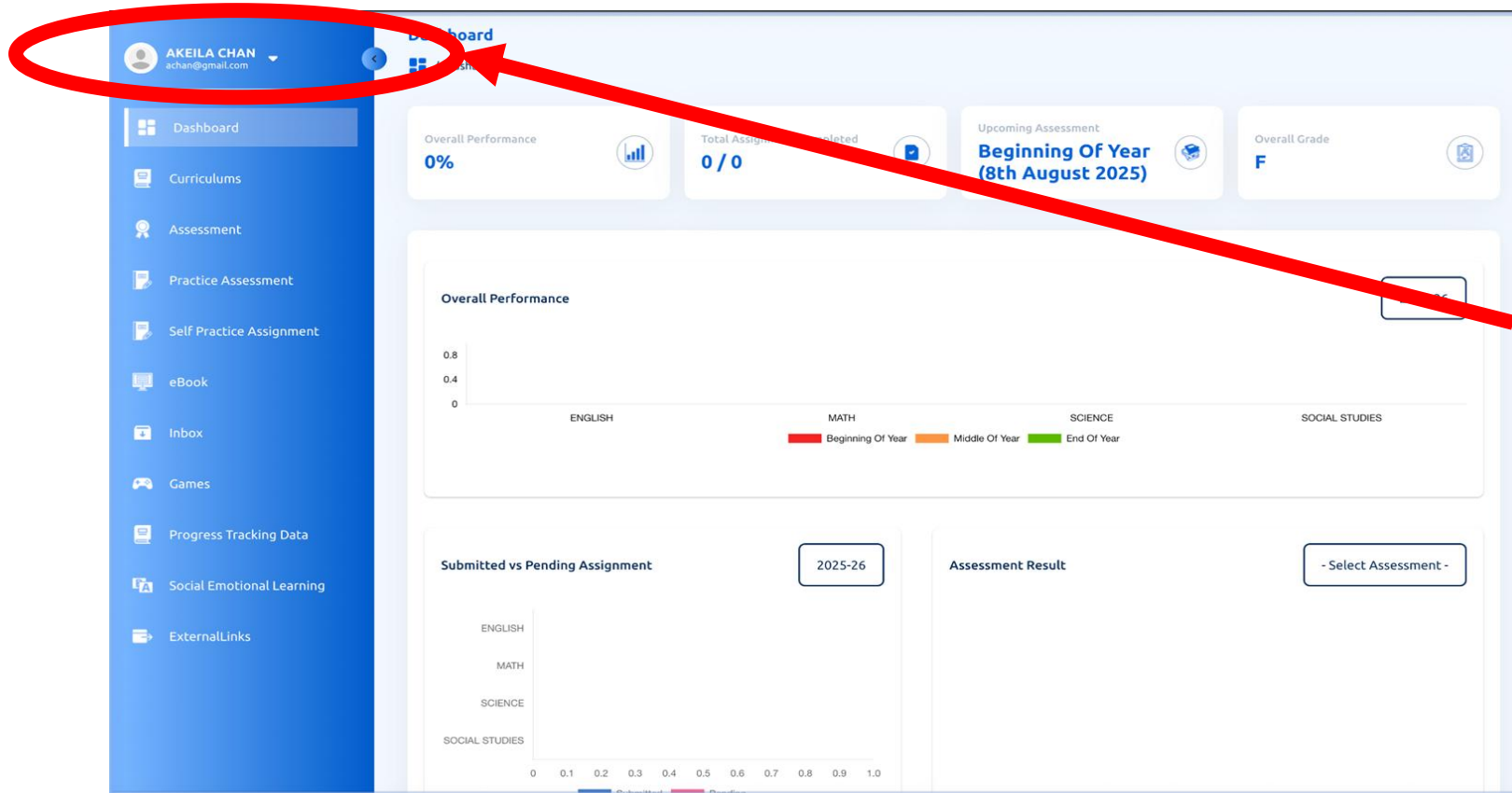
Student Profile

Step 1: Logging-in and accessing your dashboard



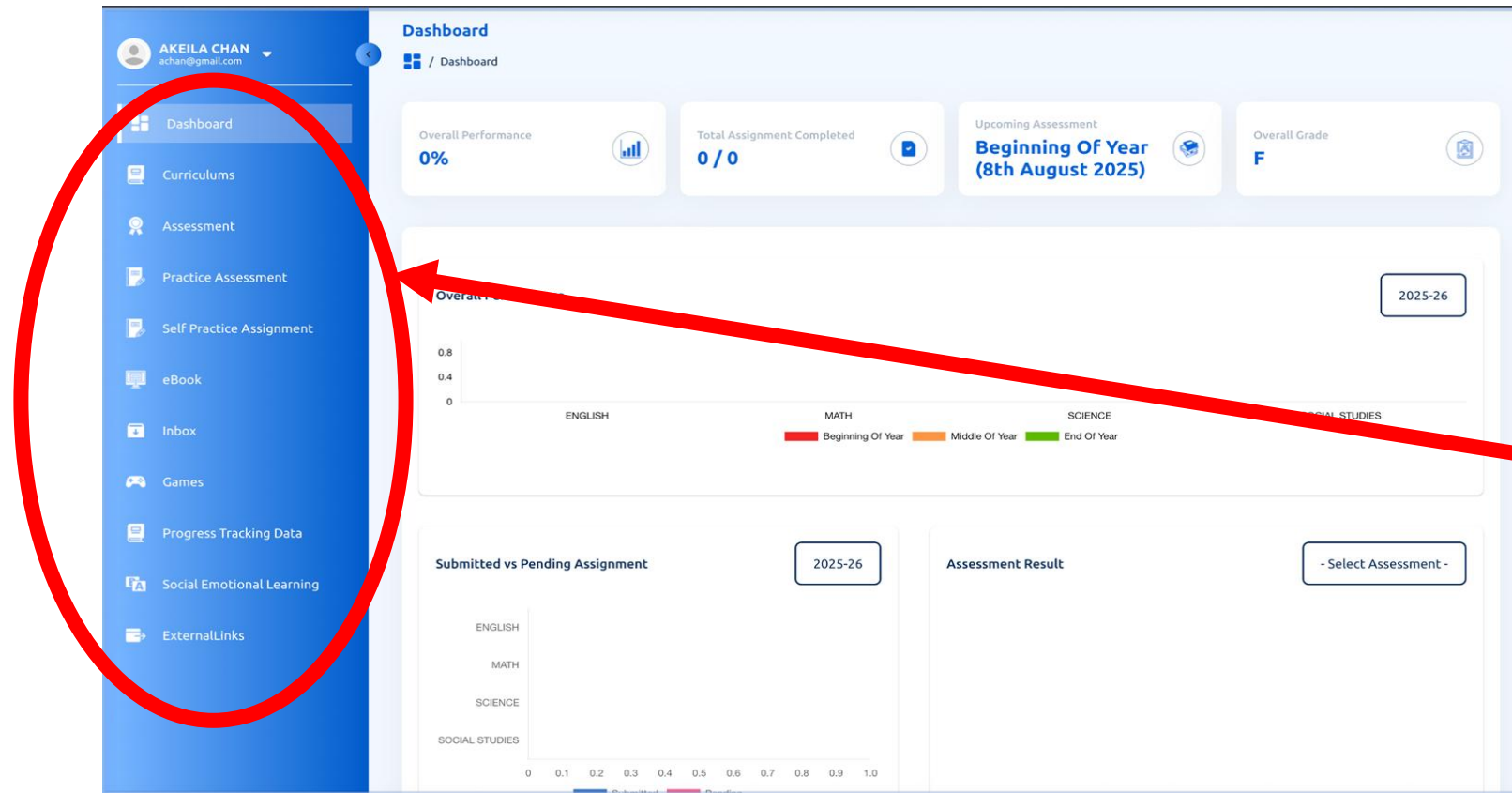
- Navigate to:
app.edugoaeducation.com
- Enter your username and password (8-10 alpha-numeric text)
- Click Login

Step 2: Navigate to the Menu–Verifying Contact Information



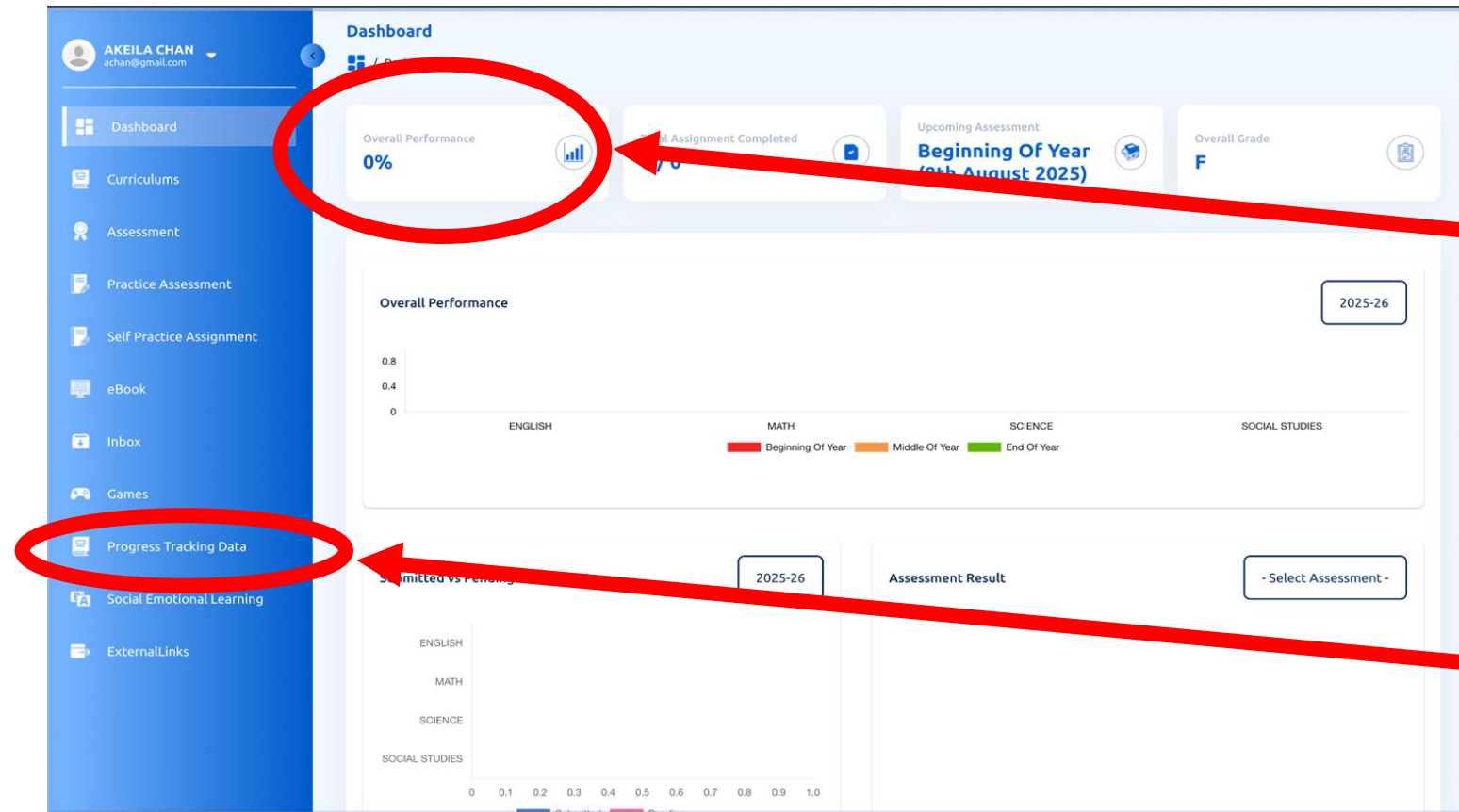
- Student names added by school/district
- Student name and email address (if available from school/district)
- Student, ensure your name is spelt correctly and email address (if available from school/district) is correct

Step 2: Navigate to the Menu-Selection Options



- **Select area of focus from menu options**
 - **Assessment:** Tests/Quizzes
 - **Progress Tracking:** Holistic view of student's performance; goes in-depth with the overall performance
 - **eBook:** Electronic textbooks uploaded by teacher/school/district
 - **Games:** Educational games for learning reinforcement

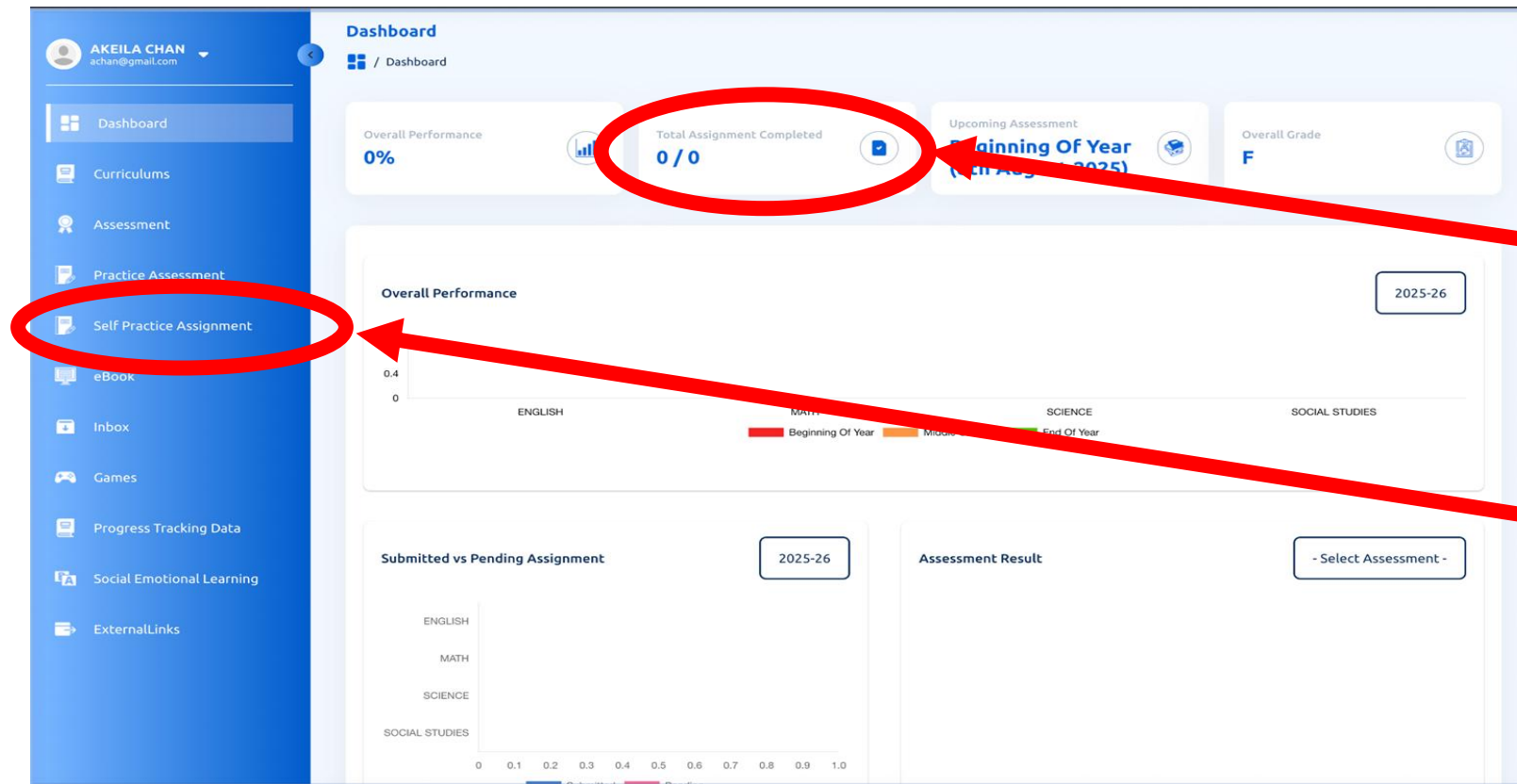
Step 3: Tracking Student Performance, Overall and In-Depth



- Student's overall performance, includes everything that will be graded for the class

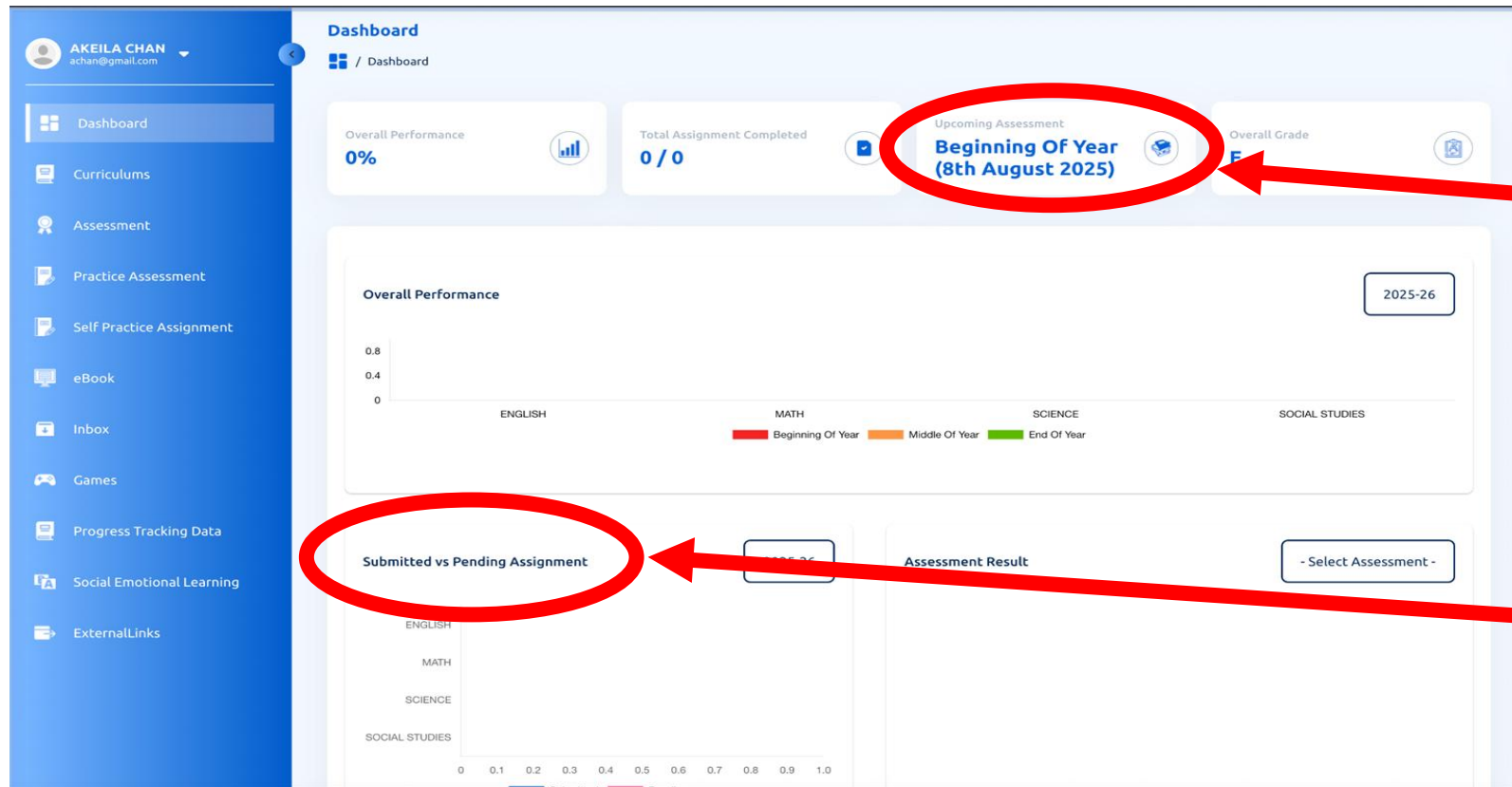
- Breakdown/in-depth view of student's performance

Step 4: Assignment Tracking and Practice Self Assessments



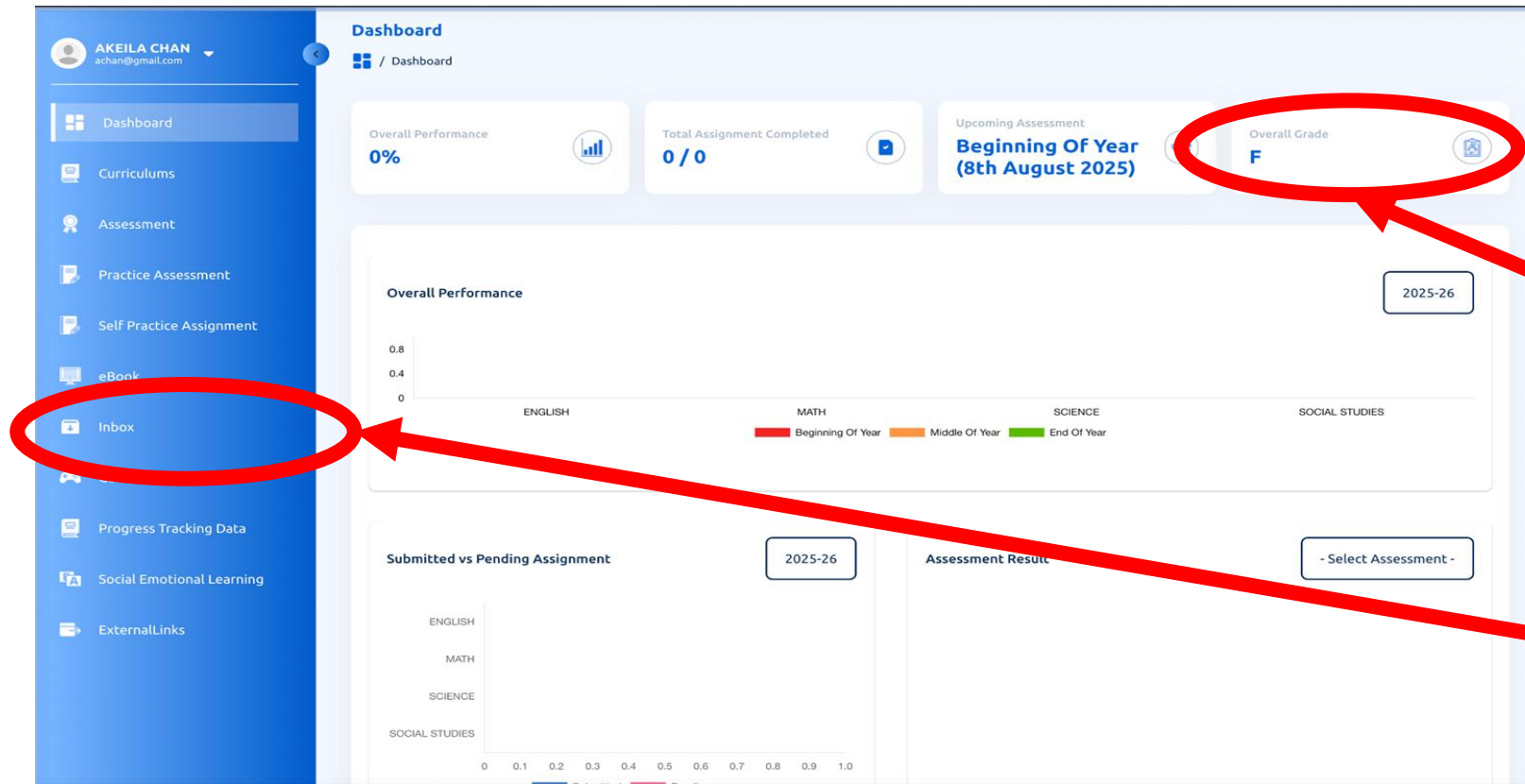
- Monitors student's assignment (homework or classwork) completion
- Ungraded, practice questions and other learning reinforcement students can complete on a self-paced basis

Step 5: Upcoming and Submitted Assignments



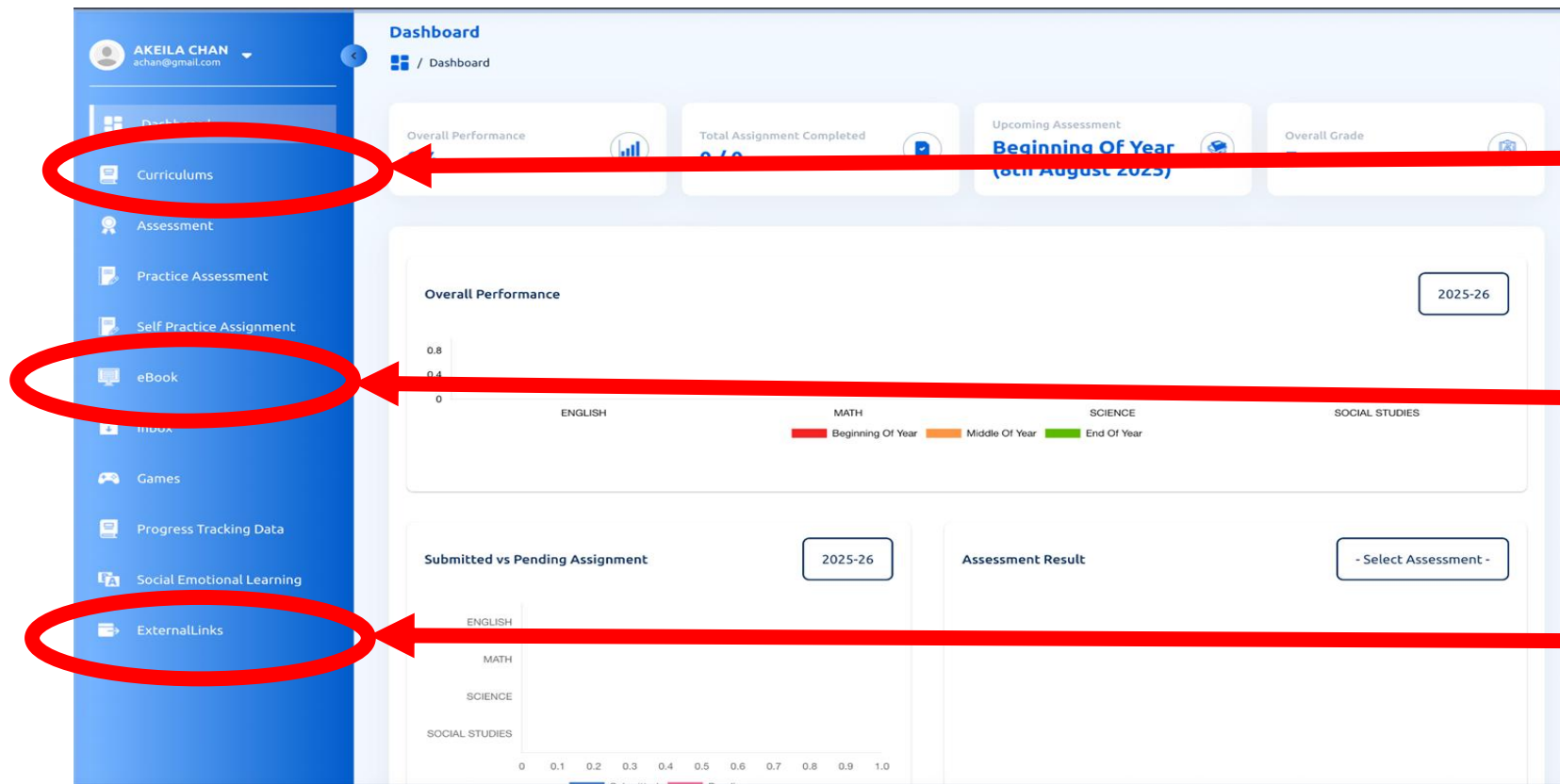
- Indicates the next, upcoming assignment
- Shows all completed and submitted assignments as well as assignments being worked on by the student

Step 6: Overall Class Grade



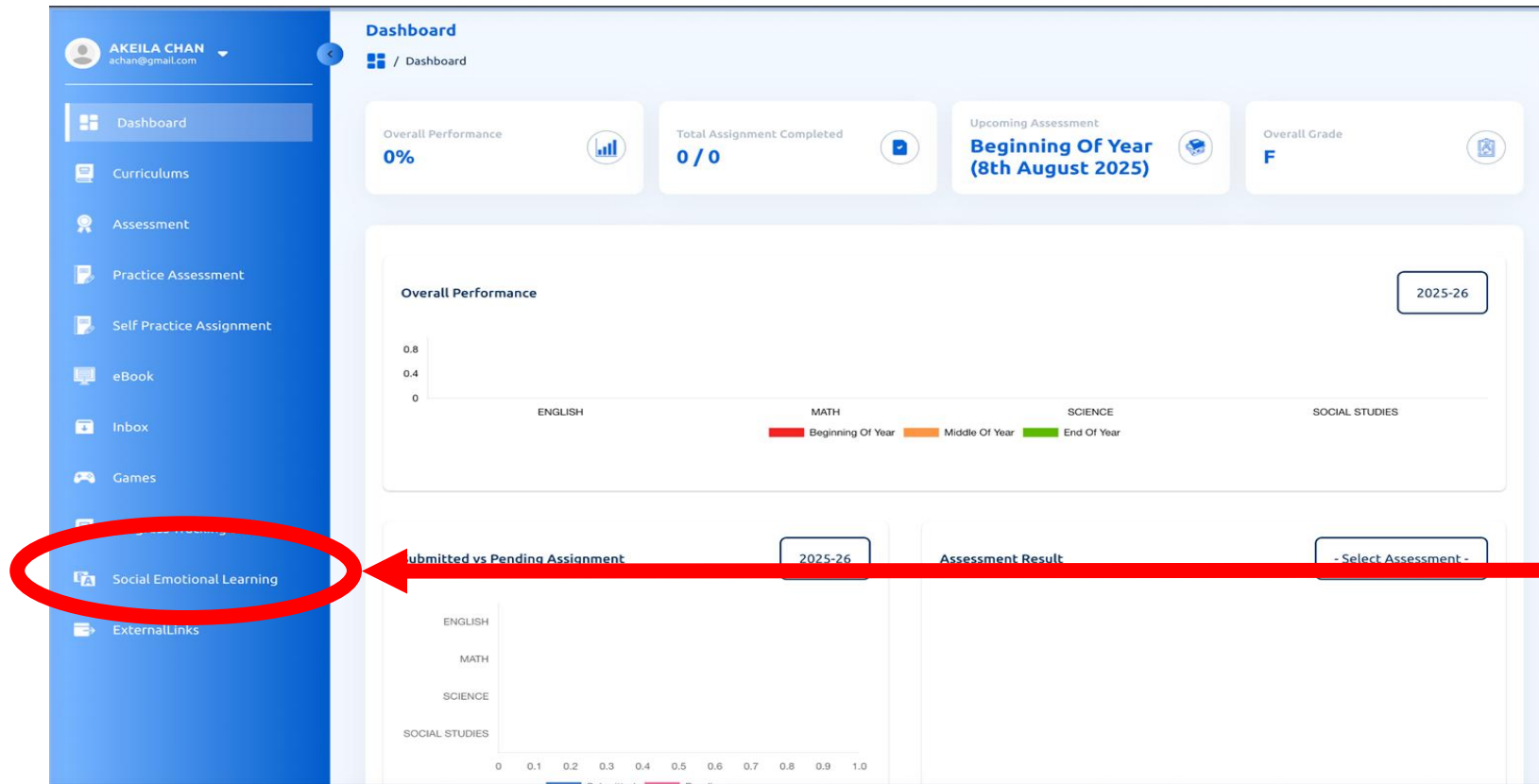
- Provides the overall class grade for the student—includes all graded portions of the class
- Indicates number of unread messages to the student; only teachers can send messages to students; students can only message teachers

Step 7: Class Curriculum and E-Books (If Available)



- Gives the lesson plans for the class, if pre-loaded by district/school/teacher
- E-textbooks for the class, if pre-loaded by district/school/teacher
- Additional links to learning resources

Step 8: Social Emotional Learning Resources and Tools



- Access to age appropriate social emotional resources for students
- Includes links and reading materials that can be printed
